

Dexmedetomidine oromucosal gel



Wear gloves when handling the syringe, administering the drug, or coming into contact with the treated dog's mouth after application.



Diethylstilbestrol



+ Avoid crushing or cutting pills and inhaling dust.



Wash or rinse exposed skin or eyes.

Estriol



Avoid crushing or cutting pills and inhaling dust.



Wash or rinse exposed skin or eyes.



Any person who is pregnant,
 breastfeeding, or trying to conceive should avoid handling.



Finasteride





Methimazole



Wear gloves when handling the bodily fluids or litter from treated animals.



Misoprostol



Avoid direct contact with bodily fluids or litter of treated animals.



Mitotane



Wash or rinse exposed skin or eyes.

Wear gloves when handling bodily fluids, feces, or litter.



★ Wear protective eyewear.



Tacrolimus



Avoid contact with skin or mucous membranes.



Wear gloves when handling bodily fluids, feces, or litter.





Wear gloves when handling bodily fluids, feces, litter, or broken or moistened tablets.



Keep medication and bodily fluids of treated animals out of reach of children.

Transdermal fentanyl



+ Take additional steps if the patch doesn't stick to the patient's skin (eg, adhesives, bandages).



Double-check patch placement regularly.

Dispose of used patch in toilet.

Trilostane



Do not empty capsule contents.





Do not attempt to divide capsules.
